

Local Area Priorities for the City of Randwick

Children and Families

- Domestic Violence prevention
- programs addressing the needs or service gaps for socially disadvantaged families and children

Older Persons

- lawn mowing services
- transport to medical appointments
- activities and services that address social isolation and/or promote community participation for at risk or elderly seniors
- activities specifically directed to CALD communities

People with Disabilities

- activities, services and program catering to the needs of people with disabilities for identified service gaps

Pre-teens (9-13 years)

- supervised, age appropriate, free or low cost activities provided after school and in school holidays for disadvantaged families in Randwick
- affordable Out of School Hours (OSHS) services for families in high need locations in Randwick
- transport services for pre-teens to attend activities at other locations in adjoining suburbs

Young People (14-19 years)

- programs, activities and projects to facilitate educational and vocational outcomes to help young people break the cycle of disadvantage or improve future employment opportunities
- affordable and structured activities that engage their interests and occupy their time after school hours
- programs or services that provide skills and training to enhance employment outcomes
- programs that steer young repeat offenders from reoffending
