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| | <p>Resolution: There was quite a big event at Clovelly Hotel on ANZAC Day, with many more people than usual and the hotel seemingly blocking off half the street with a barricade, resulting in a lot of disgruntled nearby residents. There were people allegedly drinking on the roads, dangerous traffic conditions and traffic jams. The precinct requests council to advise if all rules and regulations were complied with for this event and if there will be more of the same in the course of the year. The local community has some concerns regarding large events at the Clovelly Hotel. We request that council help arrange/facilitate for the Clovelly Hotel to meet local residents at one of our precinct meetings so we can discuss community concerns re future events at the Hotel. CARRIED</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Community garden or playground for park area in Walker St/Melrose Pde triangle Resolution: The precinct requests that Council considers better utilising the park area in the triangle (approx. 10x60 metres) between Walker St and Melrose Pde, opposite the bus shelter. Can council consider turning this triangle into a community garden or a children’s playground, with picnic tables and chairs to be used by the community. Edwin/Stuart. CARRIED. • Palm trees for median strip in Clovelly Rd Resolution: The precinct requests that council considers planting palm trees along the median strip from Walker Street, Clovelly down to the bus shelter (150-200 metres). CARRIED. • Alteration to vertical steps in Clovelly Beach pool Resolution: The precinct requests that council changes the vertical stairs in the Clovelly pool to make them accessible for everyone, as vertical stairs are not suitable for elderly people.
