COPYRIGHT DISCLAIMER

The Government Information (Public Access) Act (GIPA) provides that anyone may inspect, free of charge, certain documents held by a council, including (among others) development applications and associated documents. GIPA provides that a right to inspect a document under the Act includes a right to take away a copy of the document, whether free of charge or subject to reasonable copying charges. It follows that anyone has a statutory right to inspect development application and associated documents, subject to GIPA, and to take away copies. A council complying with its obligation under GIPA does not breach copyright law. However, a person who through this process obtains a copy of survey or other plans subject to copyright would be in breach of copyright law if those plans were later used in a way adverse to the interest of the holder of the copyright. If you do copy, reproduce, republish, upload to a third party, transmit or distribute in any way plans, building specifications or other documents subject to copyright, contrary to the provisions of the Copyright Act 1968 (Cth) you will be taken to have indemnified Randwick City Council against any claim or action in respect to breach of copyright.
