### **Maroubra Beach Precinct Meeting 28 May 2018**

Thank you for the minutes of this meeting of the Maroubra Beach Precinct.  
The Council notes the contents of these minutes.

#### **Resolution 28052018(1):**

Irrespective of motorist behaviours, the damage to the turf occurs due to the use of the area for car parking.

It is not feasible to have a Ranger or attendant present at the overflow facility. Based on the information above, it will not prevent damage to the area or the surface of the grass.

#### **Resolution 28052018(2):**

The Precinct's request has been forwarded to Council's Technical Services and Open Spaces teams to consider.

#### **Resolution 28052018(3):**

Randwick City Council congratulates the Maroubra Beach and Maroubra Central Precincts on the merger. A report will be prepared for Council to formally acknowledge the merge.

#### **Resolution 28052018(4):**

The Precinct's resolution has been forwarded to Mr Todd Clarke, Manager Infrastructure Services to provide a response.

#### **Resolution 28052018(5):**

The precincts comments regarding the Street Garden Policy have been noted.

**Resolution 28052018(6):**

Council has an ongoing budget for public art restorations. We will review previous reports on our public artwork in relation to the Tepako anchor. The maintenance will be scheduled as per our 2018/19 Public Art Budget in accordance with the Sculpture and Monument Survey.

**Resolution 28052018(7):**

The location of the community noticeboard was chosen in consultation with the previous Maroubra Beach Precinct Chair earlier this year. Council suggests the board stay in its position for a while longer before determining whether or not it should be moved.

**Update from March meeting minutes**

**Resolution 26032018(2):**

There is a large stormwater harvesting project planned for the entire Maroubra Beach Foreshore from Jack Vanny to Arthur Byrne Reserve to allow for full irrigation.

Due to a funding top up in 2018-19 Council is currently planning the commencement of stage 1 of these works in the next financial year.
