Matraville Precinct Meeting 12 June 2018

4.6 DAUNT AVENUE / POZIERES AVENUE, MATRAVILLE (M)

Road Safety - Speeding
(D03205068/D03205579-DK) (AD)

Council has received a request from the Matraville Precinct Committee and a resident of Daunt Avenue, to investigate vehicle speeds and volume from Pozieres Avenue into Daunt Avenue, Matraville. Accordingly, traffic speed, classification and volume counts have been undertaken to determine the extent of the matter.

It should be noted that the crash history of the site has been examined for the last five years, between the period of October 2012 to September 2017, and there have been no reported crashes at this location.

The results of the counts are summarised in the following tables:

**Speed & Traffic Data - Daunt Avenue, Matraville
(Between Pozieres Avenue and Paterson Street)**

Data	Eastbound	Westbound
Weekly 50 th percentile speed (km/h)	42.7	42
Weekly 85 th percentile speed (km/h)	49	47.8
Week day traffic volume	1725	1730
Seven day traffic volume	1699	1696

Based on the results of the traffic survey it can be seen that vehicle speeds are not excessive in relation to the speed limit (50km/h). Analysis of the counts show the 85th percentile speed in Daunt Avenue to be 49km/h in the eastbound direction and 47.8km/h in the westbound direction, which is below the general urban speed limit. As the volume of motorists actually exceeding the speed limit is low, it is proposed to forward the results of the survey to the Police Highway Patrol to determine if speed enforcement can be undertaken.

**Speed & Traffic Data - Pozieres Avenue, Matraville
(Between Knowles Avenue and Menin Road)**

Data	Eastbound	Westbound
Weekly 50 th percentile speed (km/h)	50	49.1
Weekly 85 th percentile speed (km/h)	56.8	55.3
Week day traffic volume	1143	1174
Seven day traffic volume	1065	1079

Analysis of the traffic and speed data reveals that the 50th percentile speed in Pozieres Avenue for westbound traffic is 49km/h and eastbound traffic 50km/h. Furthermore, the counts show the 85th percentile speed in Pozieres Avenue to be 56.8km/h in the eastbound direction and 55km/h in the westbound direction.

It is noted however that these more recent results are a significant improvement on traffic counts undertaken in October 2011 where the 85th percentile speed in Pozieres Avenue was 61km/h in the eastbound direction and 60km/h in the westbound direction.

As the percentage of motorists exceeding the speed limit is moderate it is considered the Council forward the data it has gathered to the local Highway Patrol, so that the Police may take appropriate action.

Recommendation:

That:

1. The Council forward the recent traffic count data for Daunt Avenue and Pozieres Avenue, Malabar, to the local Highway Patrol, so that the Police may consider taking appropriate enforcement action; and
2. The resident raising concerns about this matter be informed of the results
