Be over 18 and complete WIRES
Rescue and Immediate Care Course (if
caring for animals). The rescue and care
of species such as snakes and bats
requires the completion of additional
specialist courses.

You decide on the level of activity and
involvement you are comfortable with.
You can choose to only be a rescuer or
a carer, or both but time and equipment
are major considerations.

Rescuers and carers are supported by
experienced carers who will guide and
support you
