Malabar Precinct Meeting 9 March 2017

Thank you for the minutes of this meeting of the Malabar Precinct. The Council notes the contents of these minutes and I am able to provide you with the following information in response to resolutions of the meeting.

Amenity block at Malabar Pool

The Precinct's request for amenities block at the Malabar Pool has been listed for evaluation and consideration as a future improvement. However, at this stage, Council have not undertaken a full assessment and feasibility study because it is not a high priority project.

Pipe on Malabar Beach

The pipe was inspected on 19/04/17. The section of the pipe along the beach that has recently been covered appears in good order. There were kids climbing over the rocks at the time of inspection and some of the smaller rocks had been dislodged as a result of the kids' activities.

The larger boulder type rocks, which make up the majority of the new landscape improvement, appeared to be stable and secure. No large rocks were observed in the water or on the beach.

Moving back from the beach there is an older section of rock works which also appears to be in good order. No plants were observed to have fallen from the slope or above along any of the rock slope area.
