1. Objective

To emphasise Randwick City Council's total opposition to the unauthorised and unlawful erection of posters, notices and advertising material on public and private property, including telegraph poles, traffic light poles, shop facades and trailers.

2. Policy Statement

That Council, wherever possible, take appropriate action against advertisers, distributors and people who place "Bill Posters" by the taking out of an order under Section 121B of the Environmental Planning & Assessment Act.

That Council staff remove unauthorised and unlawful posters, notices and advertising material whilst at the same time pursuing enforcement options, depending on the nature and extent of the breach.

That Council advise all relevant venue operators/proprietors outlining Council's adopted policy (including, but not limited to, identified repeat offenders and local businesses).
