Business Arising</b>	<p><b>5.1 CBH Sports Bar bi-fold windows</b> - no update on Section 96</p> <p><b>5.2 Volley ball on Coogee Beach</b> (50/16) (4/17) <b>(12/17) (13/17)</b> – Council response outlined reasons why the permanent poles would not be replaced with temporary ones.  <b>Resolution 18/17:</b> That Council consider replacing the present poles with slimmer ones  <b>Resolution 19/17:</b> That the Precinct support the proposed location for the storage bin near the grit pit enclosure</p> <p><b>5.3 Sewerage pit Goldstein Reserve/sewage pollution</b> (46/16) (51/16) (52/16) (5/17) (6/17) – Councillor Neilson provided an update on the Working Group  <b>Resolution 20/17:</b> That the Precinct thank Councillor Neilson on her update</p> <p><b>5.4 Fence and banners alongside the oval</b> (55/16) (56/16) (8/17) <b>(14/7)</b> – Richard would follow up on Council response</p> <p><b>5.5 DA Notifications</b> (11/17) <b>15/17)</b>– Council response was that generally notification was to properties within 40m of the subject site and potentially high impact development required a sign on the fence etc</p> <p><b>5.6 Short term rentals</b> <b>(16/17)</b> – lengthy Council response was provided to those interested</p> <p><b>5.7 DA 116/2014/A – 58-60 Carr St</b> – no update</p> <p><b>5.8 Heritage sandstone drinking fountain</b> <b>(17/17)</b>- Council response was that the Precincts suggestion would be considered as part of the next restoration phase</p>
<b>6. New Matters</b>	<p><b>6.1 DA 10/2017 – 38 Gregory St South Coogee</b> – [Councillor Neilson left the table] - affected residents outlined their total view loss</p> <p><b>6.2 Closure of Judge Lane</b> – Council had requested the Precincts view on the request by Claremont College to close Judge Lane 8am - 4pm school days.  <b>Resolution 21/17:</b> That the Precinct opposes the closure of Judge Lane as it would be the appropriation of public land for private use and there are other options available such as lollypop control, zebra crossing etc</p> <p><b>6.3 Works in Dunningham Reserve</b> – residents from Baden Street reported that a large part of the reserve had been fenced off and trees had been removed as part of works for a submarine telecommunications cable. Attempts to contact those responsible were unsuccessful as the contact information on the signs was not correct. Councillor Neilson reported that as a result of calls from concerned residents she had written to the General Manager. She explained that it was a Federal Government matter. Council had been notified and it had requested community consultation and other protections but it had no power to refuse or amend what was proposed.  <b>Resolution 22/17:</b> The Precinct requests that Council <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- provide information to the Precinct as to the size of the works compound</li> <li>- request that Subpartners Pty Ltd provide the Environment Impact Statement (EIS)(including impact on migrating whales and native birds which use the reserve</li> <li>- request that Subpartners Pty Ltd host a local Community Information session and post the EIS online as they did for the works next to Neptune Street</li> </ul> </p> <p><b>6.4 Flood lights in Bardon Park</b> – a petition was circulating in support of having the flood lights on until 7.00pm on week nights during the winter months. The Precinct considered a resolution in support. However information provided after the meeting indicated that key people living near Bardon Park were unaware of any petition hence the Precinct will reconsider the matter at its next meeting. In the meanwhile the Precinct Executive will put relevant people in touch with one another.</p>
