	Recent positive feedback on this matter received from RMS.
	Received copy of letter to Mayor from RMS (see June minutes – 19062017(1) - re update to mayor from RMS. Since advice to Council in 2016, RMS has completed the strategic and concept design for the proposed works at the intersection. Funding has been secured to complete the detailed design this year. Expect to commence works mid-2018, subject to the detailed design. The works proposed include changing the third lane both north and south bound to dedicated right turn lanes. In addition, the new design will include red arrow displays for all pedestrian crossings when activated and new pram ramps surrounding the intersection.
