### **Matraville Precinct Meeting 8 May 2018**

Thank you for the minutes of this meeting of the Matraville Precinct. The Council notes the contents of these minutes. There are no resolutions of the Precinct that require a response through this letter.

**Resolution 08052018(1):**

Perry Street residents have long had concerns about the volume and types of vehicles travelling along their street. Whilst easing the egress from the street at Beauchamp Road will make it easier for residents to 'leave the area' it will also make it easier for "others" to use the street as a short-cut to avoid the State Road system (Bunnerong/Botany or Bunnerong/Gardeners). We caution if this is the best approach for a street where residents have long had concerns about traffic flow.

**Resolution 08052018(2):**

Introduction of right turn phases introduce delays to all phases (because every phase has to wait for the others). This will extend queue lengths along Beauchamp and along Perry. Is there a specific reason for this request? The site has not got a poor crash history and seems to function efficiently at most times.

**Resolution 08052018(3):**

Clearing the 'restriction' from a street would likely induce higher speeds along the street. Rather than encourage faster travel along this street we suggest "Crest" warning signs to alert motorists to the road conditions ahead.

**Resolution 08052018(4):**

Council will pass this request onto the RMS.
