Dear Matraville Precinct,

Matraville Precinct Meeting 19 June 2017

Thank you for the minutes of this meeting of the Matraville Precinct. The Council notes the contents of these minutes, and I am able to provide you with the following information in response to resolutions of the meeting.

Resolution 19062017(1):

To date, The Mayor has not received a response to his letter dated 8 June 2017. The precinct will be advised as soon as RMS respond.

Resolution 19062017(3):

The Precinct's request has been forwarded to Council Rangers.

Resolution 19062017(4):

Council's Integrated Transport team will forward the Precinct's request for Police patrols to monitor illegal U-turns to the Eastern Beach Local Area Command.

In relation to the precinct's request to install "No U-turn" signs (please note that the two locations specified are along Bunnerong Road, which are RMS controlled roads), previous advice received from RMS is that they do not install such signs at traffic lights. Under Rule 40 of the Road Rules 2014, it is an offence for a driver of a motor vehicle to make a U-turn at an intersection with traffic signals. Given this rule, signposting at an individual signalised intersection would not be carried out by RMS.

Resolution 19062017(6):

On Council's website, we specify:

"To help ensure your bin collection runs smoothly and enable our drivers to pick up, empty and replace your bins safely, it's important to:

- Put bins on the kerb the night before or by 5.30am on the collection day
- Position the bin with the handles facing your residence
- Leave at least a 30cm gap between your bins
- Leave at least one metre between your bin and any obstructions (such as trees, cars or poles)
- Do not overfill your bin
- Ensure the bin lid is closed to avoid spills

Bins should be returned to your property as soon as possible and not left on the kerb or on the road after collection. Bins that are placed on the road pose a risk for drivers and pedestrians and disrupt traffic."

Resolution 19062017(7):

The matter will be considered at the August 2017 Traffic Committee meeting.
