### **Malabar Precinct Meeting 8 March 2018**

Thank you for the minutes of this meeting of the Malabar Precinct. The Council notes the contents of these minutes.

#### **Resolution MAL2018-001a**

Council's Manager Waste and Cleaning Services has confirmed that Council's Public Place Officers will monitor the area and raise a service request if a clean-up is required.

#### **Resolution MAL2018-002**

The issue of traffic calming on Fisherman's Road is going to the Traffic Committee Meeting on 8 May 2018. Traffic calming devices are due to be installed. For more information, see item from the meeting agenda below:

#### *4.6 FISHERMANS ROAD, MALABAR (C) Road Safety - Speeding*

*Council has received a request from a resident of Dacre Street, Malabar, to investigate vehicle speeds in Fishermans Road due to safety concerns.*

*To ascertain the extent of the speeding issue a traffic survey was commissioned in February 2018, for a seven day period (see meeting agenda for the results table).*

*An item was tabled in the March Traffic Committee (2018.03.8.1) to install speed humps along Fishermans Road to discourage poor driver behaviour in the area. It is recommended that the area including Dacre Street and Fisherman's Road be monitored after these traffic calming measures are installed and reassessed if necessary.*

*Recommendation:*

*That:*

- 1. The results of the traffic survey for Fishermans Road, Malabar, undertaken in February 2018, be noted;*
- 2. The situation be monitored after traffic calming devices are installed along Fishermans Road, Malabar; and*
- 3. The resident raising concerns about this matter be informed of the results.*
