to him dated 23 June. We ask that this response be received by 3 August (August Precinct Meeting).

Council Response:

- *Undertake Ferguson Street traffic counts* – Traffic count was commissioned in Oct 2016 with results read out to the residents
- *Install Ferguson ST double centrelines* – This matter has been forwarded to the works team for implementation
- *Survey residents re their opinion on having No Parking across their driveways* – A resident survey regarding parking will be undertaken within 4 weeks
- *Install No Parking across driveways as agreed by community* – Subsequent to the resident survey any agreed 'no parking' controls would be referred to the Traffic Committee for consideration
- *Examine line marking situation in Fitzgerald Ave, east of Anzac Pde* – Line marking on Fitzgerald Ave was considered at the June meeting of the Traffic Committee with a recommendation to change and install line marking on Fitzgerald Avenue

- ***Robey Street retaining wall*** – sand still coming through retaining wall.

Resolution 06072017(2): The precinct requests that Council come and have another look at the retaining wall in Robey Street.

Council response: The retaining wall was reinspected recently and Council confirms that the maintenance was undertaken and that the wall is performing as expected. Council will continue to monitor as part of their ongoing asset inspection.
