Business arising	<p><i>Responses received to June resolutions:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <p>Intersection Bunnerong Rd, Franklin St & Perry St (turning arrows)</p> <p><i>Resolution 19062017(1): Could Council advise if Mayor D'Souza has received an update from the CEO of RMS regarding the intersection at Bunnerong Rd, Franklin St & Perry St (turning arrows).</i></p> <p>To date, the Mayor has not received a response to his letter dated 8 June 2017. The precinct will be advised as soon as RMS respond.</p> <p>Smash repairers parking vehicles on footpath, 7-9 Perry St</p> <p><i>Resolution 19062017(3): The precinct has observed that smash repairers on 7-9 Perry St consistently park cars on the pedestrian footpath and requests that Council rangers please patrol the site.</i></p> <p>The precinct's request has been forwarded to Council Rangers.</p> <p>Illegal U-turns on Daunt Ave</p> <p><i>Resolution 19062017(4): The precinct requests more police presence because of the many cars doing illegal U-turns outside Woolworths on Daunt Ave, on the lights, and also near Matrville Hotel. Can council put up signs saying no U-turns.</i></p> <p>Council's Integrated Transport team will forward the Precinct's request for Police patrols to monitor illegal U-turns to the Eastern Beach Local Area Command.</p>

	<p>In relation to the precinct's request to install "No U-turn" signs (please note that the two locations specified are along Bunnerong Road, which are RMS controlled roads), previous advice received from RMS is that they do not install such signs at traffic lights. Under Rule 40 of the Road Rules 2014, it is an offence for a driver of a motor vehicle to make a U-turn at an intersection with traffic signals. Given this rule, signposting at an individual signalised intersection would not be carried out by RMS.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Placement of Garbage Bins <p><i>Resolution 19062017(6): What are Council's rules and regulations on garbage bins – are they supposed to be on the road or the footpath, as they are commonly put on the road which causes parking problems.</i></p> <p>On Council's website, we specify:</p> <p>"To help ensure your bin collection runs smoothly and enable our drivers to pick up, empty and replace your bins safely, it's important to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Put bins on the kerb the night before or by 5.30am on the collection day - Position the bin with the handles facing your residence - Leave at least a 30cm gap between your bins - Leave at least one metre between your bin and any obstructions (such as trees, cars or poles) - Do not overfill your bin - Ensure the bin lid is closed to avoid spills <p>Bins should be returned to your property as soon as possible and not left on the kerb or on the road after collection. Bins that are placed on the road pose a risk for drivers and pedestrians and disrupt traffic."</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • McCauley Street survey <p><i>Resolution 19062017(7): Could council advise if they have conducted the survey regarding road closure at McCauley St and how it was done.</i></p> <p>The matter will be considered at the August 2017 Traffic Committee meeting.</p>

	<p>Resolution 10072017(2): <i>Could Council please advise how the negotiations for the lease of Purcell Park are going? Seeing that the lease finished in 2012 and we revisited the problem in February, surely we must be getting close to a new lease. How much time does it take - it has been over 5 years. Is there any feedback? Steve/Scott CARRIED</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Log Barricade outside Avion/88 Perry Street <p>Resolution 10072017(3): <i>Could Council advise when the barricade outside 88 Perry Street will be installed, the work was to be done within 4 months as refer to March minutes, it will just make reversing drivers take a little more care when entering the site. The destruction of the median strip is getting worse? The precinct would also prefer steel barricades as in front of Council's recycling depot if possible. Steve/Serge CARRIED.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Waverly and Woollahra garbage trucks seen using the Town centre and Perry St to enter Veolia <p>Resolution 10072017(4): <i>Could Council write to Waverley and Woollahra Councils to make them aware that their garbage trucks are using the Matraville Town centre and Perry Street to enter Veolia, that their employees are not complying with the DA, and ask Waverley and Woollahra Councils to stick to the route they have been given for access to Veolia? Could Council please provide the precinct with a copy of the letter they forward to Waverley and Woollahra Councils? Steve/Terry CARRIED</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sydney Side Loaders parking around Raymond Ave <p>Steve – complaints from residents re Sydney Side Loaders parking around Raymond Ave. He was driving around, drove straight into a SSL truck parked in the middle of the street outside the smash repairs near McCauley St intersection . No one in it, or the driver was asleep. Went back, got bike, took photos. Scott - DA says you can't park in adjacent streets to McCauley. Can't park in Raymond Ave. parking in middle of road is an offence. We want rangers to do a patrol around lunch time around Raymond Ave.</p> <p>Resolution 10072017(5): <i>The precinct requests Council rangers to patrol Raymond Ave around 12pm to observe parking breaches of their DA by Sydney Side Loaders.
