Business arising from previous minutes:</b>	<p>Responses to November resolutions:</p> <p><b>Greener Clovelly:</b>  <i>The Precinct's suggestion has been forwarded to Karen Hawkett, Council's Coordinator Integrated Planning and Reporting for inclusion as a precinct submission for the 2018-19 Draft Operational Plan and Budget.</i></p> <p>Stuart asked precinct members to email any ideas to him.</p> <p><b>DA537/2017 (Burnie Street):</b>  <i>The Precinct's submission has been forwarded to Louis Coorey, Council's Senior Environmental Planning Officer for consideration.</i></p> <p>Stuart and Kirsty to follow up.</p> <p><b>Hire Bikes:</b></p>

*Council are aware of the numerous bike share issues being raised by some community members. We aim to achieve a balance wherein these bikes are readily and easily available to those who wish to use them, but we also want to avoid clusters of bikes or poorly parked bikes.*

*When these bikes first commenced appearing in the Randwick Council area, we quickly realised that a regional approach had to be undertaken. This is because the riders of these bikes ride between and across different council areas. We arranged for a meeting of 11 southern Sydney councils to discuss the various concerns which we had regarding these bikes. We subsequently joined a forum with all of the bike share operators and all of the southern Sydney councils. Also in attendance were Transport for NSW and Police representatives.*

*Arising from this forum some formal Guidelines are being developed and should be finalised by the end of December 2017.*

*In the meantime, we are encouraging residents and others to contact the companies directly if they have an issue with bicycles causing an obstruction, or being placed in an inappropriate place. Requests to relocate bicycles have, in Council's experience, been quite effective.*

*We consider that, if used properly, these bikes can be a new alternative for people moving around our city. Greater use of bikes will likely reduce traffic and parking pressures throughout Sydney.*

### **37 Burnie Street, Clovelly**

*The Precinct's concerns regarding 37 Burnie Street have been forwarded to Council's Compliance Coordinator in the Health Building and Regulatory Services team to investigate and respond back to the Precinct.*

### **Return and Earn Scheme**

*The NSW Government's container deposit scheme, Return and Earn, is being introduced to reduce drink container litter. The Scheme Coordinator, Exchange for Change, will oversee the Return and Earn scheme as the financial and reporting Manager. The Network Operator, TOMRA-Cleanway, will be responsible for establishing and managing collection points and collection infrastructure across NSW.*

	<p><i>The scheme is operational from Friday, 1 December 2017. Currently there are three collection points available in the Randwick Local Government Area where our residents can return eligible containers and earn 10 cents for each.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2 for 1 Café in Clovelly Rd is one place for returns.</li> </ul>

Band advertising posters on telegraph poles</b></p> <p><b>Resolution 04122017(1):</b> Is there anything Council can do about preventing promoters putting band advertising posters up on telegraph poles? The precinct requests Council to look into contacting anybody associated with putting up posters (sponsors, venues or people putting them up) on telegraph poles. Parking in local community</b></p> <p>The precinct advises Council that there has been an increase in parking infringements, including double parking and parking across driveways, in particular around the shops in Burnie Street, especially in hot summer months.</p> <p><b>4. Fishing in Clovelly Bay - is it on the increase?</b></p> <p><b>Resolution 04122017(2):</b> Can Council clarify what the rules regarding line fishing and spear fishing are in Clovelly Bay and beyond the break area and Gordons Bay and the surrounding rock areas, and could something be put in the local Courier to remind people what these rules are. Bike trail at side of Queens Park</b></p> <p><b>Resolution 04122017(3):</b> The precinct would like to ask Council what support they are providing for the proposal in the Centennial Park masterplan for the bike trail along the south side of Queens Park, and how will council provide funding for this?. Further, can Council look into ways to extend the bike path towards the beaches, perhaps along</p>

	<p>Clovelly Road. The precinct is in support of more bike paths in the area. Gary/Stuart CARRIED</p> <p><b>6. Traffic on Arden Street</b></p> <p>There are concerns about traffic along Arden Street and surrounds, with two public schools, two childcare centres and two churches in the area. Signs are not visible; street lines have faded and traffic needs to slow down.</p> <p><b>Resolution 04122017(4)</b> – the Precinct requests a coordinated effort with Waverley Council, supporting a safer Arden St between MacPherson St and Clovelly Rd, to get a safer street, considering there are two churches, two day-care centres and two public schools in the area.
