SPORTS AWARDS CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Updated June 2023



The Randwick City Awards for Sporting Achievements (Sports Awards) are open to all disciplines of sport, including but not limited to AFL, Surf Lifesaving, Touch Football, Cross Country, Boxing, Soccer, Judo, Swimming, Netball, Oz Tag, Rugby League, Rugby Union, Table Tennis, Wheelchair Racing, Field Hockey, Water Polo, Triathalon, open water swimming, and Athletics.

The Bradley Matthews Memorial Award for Sporting Excellence is open to all sports people aged 13-18 years, who are residents of Randwick, **and** who attend school in the City of Randwick **and** who train (or are strongly affiliated with) a sporting club located within the City of Randwick. In order to allow others an opportunity, nominees are only eligible once and may not win again.

The Randwick City Junior Sports Award is open to all young sports people aged 5-12 years, who are residents of the City of Randwick, **and** who train (or are strongly affiliated with) a sporting club located within the City of Randwick.

The Randwick City Hall of Sporting Champions is open to all sports people who were born, or live, or have lived and participated in sport in Randwick City and have competed at a State or National Level. Winners are selected based on the quality of entries and there may be multiple recipients of this award.

The Randwick City Junior and Youth with a Disability for sporting excellence award is open to people with disabilities who are residents of the City of Randwick, **and** who train (or are strongly affiliated with) a sporting club located within the City of Randwick, between the ages of 5 and 18 years. There will be a junior recipient for those aged between 5-12 years and a youth recipient for those aged between 13-18 years.

The Randwick City Coach of the Year Award celebrates coaches who have made a difference to community. This Award is open to community or part-time sporting coaches who have coached a sporting team in Randwick City during the previous 12 months (July 2022 – June 2023).

Randwick Council has invited a panel of professional judges to decide the winners. The judging panel are current or former professional athletes, or have a strong affiliation with sport.

The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Applications may be accompanied by supporting documentation as outlined on the nomination form. We recommend that you highlight the greatest achievements of the athlete you are nominating. Photos, press clips and other relevant material are welcome.

Please send photocopies, not original material, as the information you submit will become the property of Randwick City Council and cannot be returned.

All personal supporting information provided by the nominator/ nominee is deemed confidential and will not be released without the nominee's permission. However a summary of each nominee's achievements may be used for publicity purposes.

Nominees must agree to be photographed by Randwick City Council. The photos may be reproduced in Randwick City Council's promotional material and the media and will remain the property of Randwick City Council.

Employees of Randwick City Council and their families are not entitled to enter.
