

# New pop-up cycleway in your neighbourhood

## Transforming Sydney's streets to protect your health

Transport for NSW is working with Randwick Council to deliver a new pop-up cycleway (see map over the page) as part of the NSW Government's response to COVID-19 to give you safe travel options. This is a key public health measure being delivered on the advice of our health experts.

## High Street Randwick

A pop-up cycleway will soon be installed in your neighbourhood. The cycleway forms part of a network that connects Waterloo to the University of NSW, the Prince of Wales Hospital precinct and Royal Randwick Racecourse.

### Pop-up cycleway High Street Randwick

- The route was chosen as High Street provides a connection to the existing cycleway on Bourke Street, Waterloo and the existing on-road cycle facilities on Doncaster Avenue, Kensington
- The pop-up cycleway will also provide access to the light rail stations on High Street and Anzac Parade, Randwick
- The pop-up cycleway will make it safer and easier for people to ride to work or study, access local services and exercise



## Pop-up location

The pop-up cycleway is planned to start at the corner of Anzac Parade and run along High Street for 850 metres to Wansey Road, Randwick.

It will be located on the northern side of the street and feature one lane going in each direction placed between the kerb and travel lanes.

Some parking spaces on the northern side of High Street, Randwick may be removed to accommodate the cycleway. Transport for NSW is currently working with Randwick Council to prepare a detailed design to determine the changes to parking that may be required.

We recognise the importance of parking to the local community and businesses so will try to reduce any parking loss where possible.

## Installation

The work to install the pop-up cycleway will start in approximately four to six weeks.

To reduce disruption to motorists and public transport users, the work will take place mostly during the night, however some work may take place during the day.


To reduce noise, hand tools will be used where possible and on-site machinery and equipment will be limited after 11pm.

More information about the installation of the pop-up cycleway will be sent shortly.

There will be temporary traffic changes while the pop-up cycleway is installed to ensure the work zone is safe. Any temporary traffic changes will be removed as soon as the cycleway is installed.
