Resolution 14102024(2): From the Council agenda of October 8th the Clovelly Floodplain Management Committee was identified as having 2 councillors and 2 community representatives. As the previous committee composition was 3 community representatives it was felt that clarification should be sought from Council on the status of the community representatives.

Resolution 14102024(3): That the Council Traffic Committee explore the possibilities of providing 90 degree parking in Burnie Street, installed on the norther side of Burnie Street between Winchester Road and Clifton Road or elsewhere in the vicinity, to create up to 20 parking spaces along this section of road.

Council response

There seem to be only 11 parking spaces existing upon the northern side of Burnie Street, from Winchester Road to Clifton Road, Clovelly. Conversion of this parking arrangement from parallel parking to 90° angle parking may result in a small increase of 11 additional parking spaces. I have tasked one of the Council's Transport Engineers to undertake a more detailed assessment, including on-site measurements and traffic counts / observations.

With our current busy schedule, we anticipate that we would provide the Precinct with a more detailed response by May 2025. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

Resolution 14102024(6): That the council review the condition of the picnic shelters on the north side of Clovelly Beach and consider renovating them.

Council response.

As previously mentioned in March 2024 in Resolution 11032024(3), Council is aware of the current situation. One of the three structures was removed in late February 2024 by the team for safety reasons as the structure was compromised. The remaining two structures have been investigated and remain safe however are dated and well worn.

Funding has been provided in 24/25 Operational Plan and Budget – Capital Works for the replacement of the removed picnic shelter, with the team currently in procurement of this shelter.
