TERMS AND CONDITIONS



RANDWICK CITY COUNCIL MAYOR DYLAN PARKER'S CHRISTMAS CARD COMPETITION 2025

1. STANDARD TERMS

By entering the Randwick City Council's Mayor's Christmas Card Competition you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

2. ENTRY

- 2.1 Entry is open to all students attending schools from K to 6 in the Randwick LGA.
- 2.2 Students living outside Randwick LGA but attending schools in the LGA are eligible to enter the competition.
- 2.3 The competition will have 3 categories: K to Year 2, 3-4 & 5-6. The selected artworks in each category of the Christmas Card competition will have their submission featured as the Mayor's Christmas card for 2025 as well as on street banner flying across town centres.

3. HOW TO ENTER

- 3.1 The competition commences on Tuesday 9 September 2025 and closes at 4pm on 10 October 2025.
- 3.2 In order to enter the competition entrants must fill out and return the competition entry form to Council. Entries provided not using the entry form will still be accepted provided it includes the child's name, year and school.
- 3.3 Multiple entries from the same person will not be accepted.
- 3.4 The winner must submit their real name and details. Fake or fictious names will not be eligible to win.
- 3.5 Randwick City Council will not be liable for any late, lost or misdirected entries.
- 3.6 Incomplete, incorrect or incomprehensible details will, at the sole and absolute discretion of Randwick City Council, invalidate the participant's entry into the Competition

4. PRIZES

5. HOW TO WIN

- 5.1 The winners of the competition will be chosen by Mayor Cr. Dylan Parker on Friday 17 October 2025.
- 5.2 The winners will be notified by email and/or telephone through their school. Their first name, year and school of the winners will be published on Council's website and may be published in other public forums. The same details will also be published along with their artwork on the Mayor's Christmas Card for 2025.
- 5.3 Randwick City Council's decision is final and correspondence regarding the result will not be entered into.
- 5.4 Randwick City Council reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entry which, in the opinion of Council, includes objectionable content, profanity, potentially insulting, inflammatory or defamatory statements, disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process, who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these terms and conditions of entry, or who has, in the opinion of Council, engaged in conduct in entering the promotion which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the promotion and/or Council. Council reserves the right to disqualify a winner if Council becomes aware that the winner and/or the winner's entry is of a type described in this clause.

6. NO LIABILITY

- 6.1 Council accepts no liability in the event that any outside act, agent or event should significantly hinder or prevent the competition.
- 6.2 Council will not be held liable for any misadventure, accident, injury, loss (including but not limited to consequential loss) or claim that may occur:
 - a) during the competition,
 - b) in the participation in any prize;
 - c) due to the broadcast of any program relating to the competition or the publication of any material, including any statements made by any staff member, journalist, other entrants or any other person;
 - d) in relation to failure of an online entry to be received by Council on account of technical problems or traffic congestion;
 - e) arising from or related to any problem or technical malfunction of any telephone or internet network or lines or mobile communications network or website related to or resulting from participation in this promotion; or
 - f) due to circumstances outside Council's reasonable control.

To the extent permitted by law, the winning entrant and their companion must exclude, release and forever discharge the Promoters, and all other persons involved in the conduct, promotion and organisation of this promotion, and their respective employees, officers, agents and contractors from all liability for claims, loss, damage, cost or expenses (whether arising under statute, from negligence, personal injury, death, property damage, infringement of third party rights or otherwise) arising from or in connection with the participation in the prize or otherwise howsoever arising.

PARENTAL/GUARDIAN CONSENT REQUIREMENT

- 7.1 Schools take responsibility for distributing information about the competition to eligible students.
- 7.2 Council assumes that all entries received in this competition have consent from the student, school and parents and guardians.
- 7.3 Council staff will contact the school of each winner to notify them of the winners and requesting that they notify the winner's parents or guardian. Council will endeavour to present the winner with their certificate and prize at a school function in collaboration with the school.

8. PRIVACY INFORMATION

8.1 Personal information supplied by participants in the competition will be kept private in accordance with Council's Privacy Policy.

9. OWNERSHIP AND RETURN OF ARTWORK

- 9.1 All submitted artworks remain the property of the entrants
- 9.2 Randwick City Council will not sell any entries submitted to the competition for financial gain.
- 9.3 Upon request by the entrant, Council will return all artworks to the entrant's school after the competition ends.
- 9.4 Digital copies of the artwork will be kept on file, but Council will dispose of the original artwork within one month of the conclusion of the competition, unless otherwise notified.
