

How to FOGO?



Line your caddy with a AS4736 certified compostable liner, newspaper or paper towel

Place your food scraps into your caddy

When your caddy is full, transfer your scraps into your FOGO bin

Add garden waste in your FOGO bin along with your food waste

Put your FOGO bin out for collection each week.

Did you know?

By using your FOGO bin, you are reducing greenhouse gas emissions and helping to produce a high quality compost for farmers to help grow more food.

Your green lid FOGO bin is just for kitchen food scraps and garden waste.

Your FOGO bin is collected every week. Please refer to your waste calendar for your collection days.

FOGO tips

How to best manage your FOGO bin.

1. Where possible, store the FOGO bin in the shade.



2. Ensure that the kitchen caddy is closed.



3. Place some leaves or grass clippings at the bottom of the bin and on top of food scraps to reduce odour.



4. Freeze your meat and seafood scraps, wrap them in newspaper or used paper towel and place them in the bin the night before collection.



5. Wash your caddy regularly with warm soapy water. Sprinkle bicarbonate of soda in the base to help absorb liquids and odours.



6. Use a compostable liner or wrap your food scraps with newspaper.



Need more liners?



If you run out of liners, you can order more for free by visiting randwick.nsw.gov.au/FOGO



When purchasing liners, only purchase green-coloured, certified compostable liners with this symbol.

Do not use biodegradable liners or plastic bags - they contaminate the bin.

You can also use newspaper or paper towels to line your caddy or place your scraps directly in the bin.
