Resolution 11032024(1) - Can council place some speed monitoring device to measure of speed of traffic in Perry and Franklin St especially after 9pm daily.

# **Council response:**

The item relating to speed and volume counts along Perry Street and Franklin Street in Matraville was submitted to the August Local Traffic Committee meeting held on 13 August 2024.

The recommendations from this meeting were that:

- a) The results of the traffic surveys for Perry Street and Franklin Street, Matraville, undertaken 15 June 2024, are noted,
- b) The detailed results of the traffic count be forwarded to the local Police Highway Patrol for consideration of appropriate speed enforcement action.
- c) The precinct raising concerns about this matter be informed of the results of the survey, the proposed notification to the local Police Highway Patrol, and, that the Council will seek from TfNSW a reduction in the speed limit of Franklin and Perry Streets, from 60km/h to 50km/h.

The details of the traffic counts have now been forwarded to the local Police Highway Patrol for consideration and appropriate action.

In addition, Council officers will be seeking from TfNSW a speed reduction of Franklin and Perry Streets from 60km/h to 50km/h.

## NOTIFICATION: Perry Street, Matraville - Illegal parking on median islands

Local residents have raised concerns regarding illegal parking within the median islands on Perry Street, Matraville, between McCauley Street and Baird Avenue. Additionally, Council's Open Space Services department are facing difficulties in maintaining the vegetation due to this parking behaviour.

According to NSW Road Rule Number 197:

"A driver must not stop on a bicycle path, footpath, shared path or **dividing strip**, or a nature strip adjacent to a length of road in a built-up area".

Given the concerns raised by residents, Council Rangers Services will soon be undertaking additional patrols within the area and any breaches may result in Penalty Infringement Notices being issued.

# **Council response:**

Thank you for your patience.

To address the issue of illegal parking on the median islands of Perry Street in Matraville, Council Officers have issued a notification letter to the residents and businesses of Perry Street two (2) weeks ago (during mid-June 2024). A sample notification is attached for your reference.

Additionally, Council Ranger Services will be increasing patrols in the area. Any violations may result in Penalty Infringement Notices.

We hope this will resolve the illegal parking along this stretch of road, potentially eliminating the need for log fences at this time.

#### **Resolution:**

Resolution 11032024(4) – Council to investigate the widening of roads in Matraville precinct to accommodate with the rapid building of duplexes in South ward. Currently with the increased in dwellings, number of cars increasing could we look at how we can increase road width.

## **Council response:**

Widening of roads involves either the acquisition of private land to widen the road reserve or widening of the carriageway by realigning the kerb and gutter. The existing width of the carriageway would need to be widened by 1.5-2m to accommodate an additional traffic lane. This latter option would impact street trees, power poles, drainage structures and driveway grades.

A blanket widening of roads as described above is very complex and even if it were possible to achieve, would require the level of funding that does not make such a proposal feasible.

It is noted that the request is in response to the development of duplexes. The increase in traffic arising from this development is incremental and would not warrant the road widening.

Resolution 11032024(5) – Matraville precinct would like to know the council policy in respect to registering of trees on council median strips and parks and in private area that are classified as significant trees.

# **Council response:**

Our current Register of Significant Trees is a heritage assessment of private and public trees within the LGA. Inclusion onto the register is not based on size and maturity.

Currently there is no process for adding trees to the Significant Tree Register. The original list was developed in consultation with the public including nominations of trees for the register.

The Register of Significant Trees is available on Randwick City Council's website here.

A review and update of all associated policy documents including the Register of Significant Trees is planned to be undertaken in the near future. This review will also include a mechanism for adding trees to the register.

Irrespective, mature and prominent trees are protected by our policies and provisions in the Develop Control Plan. Similarly, if a tree listed in the register is in poor health, is hazardous or is causing damage to private dwellings, then council may resolve for its removal.
