The site for this project is located at 424 Anzac Parade Kingsford which is attached to O'deas Corner - a heritage-listed building under the Randwick Local Environmental Plan 2012 and shown in Figure 4b (Randwick City Council, 2020, p.30). The project takes into consideration of the micro-dwelling and heritage conditions of the building; hence the design consists of modular elements and sustainable material choice.



Essentially, the interior of the apartment is suited for two people, however, the public has access to the urban intervention located at the first floor to create larger assembly where dining, discussions, rest, and ideation can occur. This is where the magic happens. Enveloped by the kombucha fabric, one may feel endowed to follow the nature's pleas - to protect the planet for a liveable and healthier community. Thus, an earnest discussion will follow through with the other individuals of the same mindset, housing the city to foster healthy, creative, culturally rich and socially connected communities. This project supports the Randwick Council's visions and aims to create a city for their people where one feels connected where they go, and to turn streets as places.



Providing practical and attractive bicycle parking facilities is essential to meeting Sydney's goals in encouraging bike riding in the general public. Through research, it was identified that Randwick is lacking in bike related infrastructure, most notably in recreational spaces such as parks, so it became a problem I would like to tackle. The design focuses to target these aspects based on the analysis of the need and problem from both the cyclist and none-cyclist point of views, which outlined security, appeal and sense of community as main topics to address.

In this design, form is used to communicate a sense of stability to the human eye through perfect geometry and coverage across the bike's envelope. The design has a recognizable leaf like side profile, aiming to appeal to and engage people's attention as they walk down the sidewalk, promoting biking as a healthy and eco-friendly lifestyle. The leaf like form is then extended in three dimension to create a flowing pattern that embraces the parked bikes as a collective group, creating a sense of "parking with" instead of "parking beside" others. Material and manufacturing opportunities and restrictions have been considered to find not only an effective but also probable solution to the problem. These features combined aims to tackle the problems identified in early stages, to target the wider goal of encouraging bike riding in Randwick.


