| <b>Resolution 1</b>                           | That the (rarely used) bus shelter on the corner of Gubbetah Road and Anzac Parade be moved to the bus intersection in Anzac Parade near Pine Street. (Peter/Carol)   |
| <b>Resolution 2</b>                           | That Randwick Council provide their action plan to prevent car hoons in the Bays and Precincts general area, and more specifically in the Bunnerong Road, La Perouse loop and Anzac Parade. (Carol/Adrienne)  |
| <b>Resolution 3</b>                           | That traffic calming measures be introduced in Elaroo Ave which do not include any devices which cause vehicles to bounce up and down.  |
| <b>Resolution 4</b>                           | That the council takes immediate action against the illegal parking in the centre of Anzac Pde between Jennifer St and Bunnerong Rd.(Rose/Chris)  |
| <b>Resolution 5</b>                           | The precinct meeting thanks Noel D'Souza for organising a ATM in Matraville. (Peter/Carol)  |
| <b>Resolution 6</b>                           | That the council look into the fire danger that dead trees represent inside the strip of bush along Bunnerong Road, near the skating Rnk (Peter/ )  |

| <b>Coffee Cart on Golf Course</b>             | There are plans afoot to permanently have a coffee cart/caravan near the Little Bay Beach entrance, on the grounds managed by the golf course. The cart is highly visible and not in keeping with the natural look of the area. It's presence also creates a lot of scattered litter, which does not enhance the beauty of the area. Additionally, there is a permanent coffee shop not 50 meters away.<br>Someone suggested that this issue should also be taken up with the community association.  |
| <b>Parking issues</b>                         | Most of Randwick appears to be reasonably well policed for illegal parking, however, when you go past the jail (in the Little Bay/La Perouse direction), parking seems to be a free for all and the area looks ugly for it. (This seems to be a hot button issue) Cars, caravans, trailers, boats etc are parked on the green strip in the green centre strip of Anzac Pde, and the problem is becoming increasingly worse.<br>The counter argument is that if you move them, they will park somewhere else. However, RCC was able to successfully introduce parking measures in place in Bundock St, which now looks like a street again, but this appears to have moved the problem to the Bays and Beaches area. |
| <b>Car hoons</b>                              | Bill: Bayside council (Christina Curry) introduced noise measuring equipment and send fines immediately to offenders. Motion (see above) find out noise of car hoons still persists. Bayside council reported success with their noise activated camera program. What are the RCC plans.  |
| <b>Chifley Play fields and sports grounds</b> | It was reported that the council action was successful, and the area has improved and appears to be managed well and children can play safely in their designated area. The sports grounds are left very tidy and clean.  |

| <b>Gubetah Rd Bush Reserve;<br/>Bunnerong Rd bush near Skating rink</b> | Some residents express concerns about the large number of dead trees in these reserves and the fire danger this may present. Peter will raise the matter with Matt Leary and discuss what can be done about it.<br>It was noted that the strip of bush along Bunnerong Road is not council land and therefore not their responsibility. |
| <b>Blocked drain</b>  | The blocked drain in Anzac Pde near Jenner Street was “blasted” clean and there should be no further flooding issues.   |
| <b>Lasseter Ave</b>   | Council has no record of No-Stopping signs being present. Stuart will contact council staff directly. Could Council please provide details for a direct contact.  |
| <b>Elaroo Ave</b>   | Current traffic calming devices still cause loud noise. RCC has finished their review in July, but we have had no follow up. Bill will raise this issue with the Traffic Meeting with council on 26/09. Motion: to this effect is raised above.   |
| <b>Ferry Wharf</b>  | It’s now official, that the ferry wharf will have no ferry, and recently has been renamed from Kamay Ferry Wharf to Kamay Wharf. One side of the wharf will be for private boats, the other side for commercial boats. It is not officially known who or how this wharf will be managed.  |
| <b>Local Cemetery</b>   | Adrienne: Friends of the Coast Cemetery – Adopt a Grave is a new initiative being developed. The cemetery is now part of the National Park.   |
| <b>Historic walks</b>   | Adrienne: in conjunction with the Nurses Museum, is trying to organise guided walks around Little Bay and looking for some financial support from Randwick Council  |
