1. Objective

To provide for an equitable, consistent and predictable street address numbering system in Randwick City that reflects and follows land subdivision and development sequences.

2. Policy statement

1. That wherever possible, addresses and sub-addresses must be allocated in accordance with the [NSW Address Policy and User Manual](#)
2. That street address numbering and re-numbering will not be undertaken for cultural, social, religious, or superstitious reasons.
3. That sub-addresses across the same site shall not be repeated, including where a site has multiple entrances or an alternate address. i.e. having both a Shop 1 & Unit 1.
4. That ranged addresses are to no longer be used e.g 6-10

Further provisions relating to street addressing and sub addressing for residential land uses are contained in sections C1 5.5 and C2 4.5 of the [Randwick Development Control Plan](#) (DCP)
