<p>RESOLUTION (Committee) The Precinct noted the Randwick City Council and La Perouse Local Aboriginal Land Council proposal to transform the La Perouse Museum and surrounding headland into a dedicated First Nations Cultural Precinct, co-designed with and led by the local Aboriginal community.</p> <p>In view of the development cost (\$99 million estimate) and recurring operational expenditure (unstated) of the proposal, and its scope and impact on both the La Perouse Museum and the La Perouse headlands, the Precinct requests that Randwick Council organise:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A community information event where the proponents can explain the proposal to the South Ward community and listen to resident feedback. 2.
