6. Correspondence	 Council update to Resolution 06092023(2) speed study on Darley Road. The traffic count data has been recently received. 8. General Business	 St Marks Road parking constraint was discussed, including two spaces outside Spaghetteria approved for night time activation. Council has not progressed the rear to kerb parking survey. Concern was raised about rear to kerb compromising safe exit from driveways. Cr Pandolfini suggested car-share and cycling could solve parking concerns. Outdoor dining: Cr Pandolfini praised the new upcoming night time economy trial in St Marks Road and The Spot adding that there are many vibrant cities where street dining works to stimulate the night time economy. Leanne advised that she and Katrina were resigning from the Precinct Committee and asked residents to consider nominating at the AGM. Cr Pandolfini suggested younger people would be more inclined to attend precinct meetings if there was less discussion about cars and parking. Quorum was not met and the meeting was ended at the request of Cr Neilson.
