Resolution 23042025(1): Bays and Beaches Precinct requests Randwick City Council to consider the application by the Boatshed at La Perouse to extend its liquor licence and its trading hours for any adverse impacts on the local community and on the amenity of nearby public places, celebration and worship and for Council to take appropriate action including making a submission to Liquor NSW.

Council response

The Boatshed La Perouse operating at 1609 Anzac Parade La Perouse currently has development consent for the following hours of operation:

Monday to Thursday: 7:00am to 10:00pm

Friday to Sunday: 7:00am to 11:00pm

Council has received a notification from the Office of Liquor and Gaming for the liquor licence application for a primary service authorisation which seeks to supply or serve alcohol at premises to customers who are not using or consuming other products or services (for example food). The application is seeking to use the existing areas approved on the current liquor licence and not seeking to change the boundaries or the hours of operation.

Council officers will provide a submission to the Office of Liquor and Gaming with Council's concerns and request the Applicant demonstrate to Council by way of Management Plan or other documented strategy that the use of the premises will remain that of a restaurant/cafe at all times and the provision of alcohol will not become the dominant feature at the Premises.
