Public spaces and homelessness

Randwick City Council looks
after public spaces to keep
them clean, safe and open for
everyone to use.

What we ask from people sleeping rough:

- Pack up and store your personal belongings each day. Keep items to what can be carried in a backpack or suitcase.
- Move if the area is unsafe, needs cleaning or is blocking access.
- Don't camp or light fires.
- Don't drink alcohol in alcohol-free zones.

What Council staff will do:

Randwick City Council looks after
public spaces to

- Keep areas clean and safe. Unattended items will be removed and valuable items will be stored for 28 days.
- Share information about local services like housing, health care, food, transport, public toilets and showers, and Council rules.
- Work with support services and police to help protect people's health and safety.
