While speed cushions are to be installed on both approaches to the pedestrian crossing near St Brigid’s Church (135C Brook St) to increase pedestrian safety, The Precinct would still advocate a 40Km speed limit in the area bounded by Dudley, Mount, Dolphin and Arden Streets.</p> <p>9.5 Trailer / Caravan parking. Parking restrictions on Bundock Street have resulted in the transfer of these to street in Coogee particularly Dolphin Street (both sides west of Mount Street)and Dudley Street near Baker Park and western end of Coogee Bay Road. The situation in Dolphin Street has resulted in parking access problems for people attempting to access the playground and the local playgroup and for residents.
