Council response

Trees have been removed illegally in June of this year. Council was notified by a resident in Hunter Avenue at the time of the trees being cut down and attended the following day. A Council ranger spoke with the resident, who provided their name and contact telephone number. Council's Urban Forest Planner has recently contacted the resident again about further information to assist with Council's investigation. They were unable to provide information personally but advised that another resident in the vicinity witnessed the tree removal and has agreed to contact them for assistance. We are currently awaiting information.
