What goes in the FOGO bin?

Your green lid FOGO bin is just for kitchen food scraps and garden waste.

Put these in your FOGO bin

FOOD SCRAPS



- ✓ Raw or cooked leftover food



- ✓ Meat, bones and seafood



- ✓ Eggs and dairy products



- ✓ Fruit and vegetable scraps

GARDEN WASTE



- ✓ Branches under 10cm in diameter



- ✓ Prunings



- ✓ Leaves



- ✓ Grass

Top 5 FOGO tips



- 1 Shut it**
Keep your FOGO bin and kitchen caddy shut tightly.



- 2 Shade it**
Where possible, place your FOGO bin in the shade.

- 3 Freeze it**
Freeze your meat and seafood scraps and put them in the bin the night before collection.



- 4 Cover it**
Cover the food waste in your bin with some dry leaves and garden waste.



- 5 Wash it**
Regularly wash your bin and kitchen caddy.

Make sure they have the **AS4736 compostable logo**.

Yellow lid recycling bin

These **CAN** go in this bin as loose items



✓ **Glass bottles and jars** (unbroken)



✓ **Plastic bottles and containers**



✓ **Cartons** (milk, juice etc)



✓ **Aluminium, steel and empty aerosol cans**



✓ **Paper and magazines**



✓ **Cardboard** (flattened)

These **CANNOT** go in this bin

✗ **Batteries and battery-operated devices**

✗ **Electrical items**

✗ **Plastic bags**

✗ **Disposable coffee cups**

✗ **Clothing**

✗ **Bagged recyclables**

✗ **Building materials**

✗ **Cling film**

✗ **Soft plastic wrappers**

✗ **Plastic toys**



Have you got excess recycling?

Items that go in your recycling bin can also be dropped off at the **Randwick Recycling Centre** free of charge.

This is helpful for larger cardboard boxes or during holiday seasons when you may have more recyclables.

Randwick Recycling Centre

The Randwick Recycling Centre accepts a range of items including excess recyclables, and items listed.

Household problem waste and chemical waste

- ✓ **Fluorescent globes and tubes**
- ✓ **Gas bottles and fire extinguishers**
- ✓ **Household and car batteries**
- ✓ **Motor oil and other oils**
(cooking, etc)
- ✓ **Paints**
(water, oil and solvent based)
- ✓ **Smoke detectors**
- ✓ **Steel and aluminium aerosol cans**
- ✓ **Polystyrene**
- ✓ **X-ray films**
- ✓ **Blister packs**
- ✓ **Corflute signs**
- ✓ **Soft plastics**
(biscuit packaging, bread bags, newspaper wrap, plastic film etc).
- ✓ **Wearable clothing, including shoes, handbags, accessories, and manchester. You may prefer to donate them first.**

Electronic waste

- ✓ **Computers and peripherals**
(mice etc)
- ✓ **Televisions**
- ✓ **Mobile phones**
- ✓ **Ink cartridges**
- ✓ **Printers**

Red lid general waste bin

Your red lid general bin is for all household rubbish that can't be recycled. Reducing the waste that goes into your red bin means less will end up in landfill. **Before you throw it out, ask yourself if it can be donated, reused or recycled.**

These CAN go in this bin as loose items



✓ Broken household items



✓ Broken glass and crockery



✓ Nappies



✓ Polystyrene



✓ Plastic bags*



✓ Snack wrappers*



✓ Pet waste

* These items can be recycled as soft plastic at the Randwick Recycling Centre. Please consider taking them there.

Book a clean-up

Every household in Randwick City is entitled to **SIX (6) free clean-up services** each year. This includes:

- **ONE (1) scheduled clean-up**

Refer to your waste calendar for your scheduled date.

- **FIVE (5) on call clean-ups**

Call to schedule a pick-up.

Items we collect

- ✓ Furniture
- ✓ White goods
- ✓ Small household appliances
- ✓ Toys
- ✓ Plastics (plant pots, baby baths, buckets etc)
- ✓ Mattresses
- ✓ BBQs
- ✓ Garden waste
- ✓ Empty paint tins
- ✓ E-waste (computers, printers, TVs etc)
- ✓ Gym equipment

Items we don't collect

- ✗ General rubbish
- ✗ Business or commercial waste
- ✗ Building material (including fencing)
- ✗ Hazardous waste incl. asbestos
- ✗ Tyres
- ✗ Bean bags
- ✗ Gas bottles or empty drums
- ✗ Car and boat parts
- ✗ Liquids (paint, chemicals, oils etc)

Get your things ready for collection

- Place your things outside between the kerb and footpath **the day before your collection date.**
- **Separate your items by type.**
Items are collected by separate trucks for recycling.

Moving house?

To ensure your service is scheduled on your preferred day, book your free clean-up at least **2 WEEKS** before your moving date.

Putting rubbish on the kerb without booking a clean-up is considered illegal dumping. Fines apply.
