# Swim school enrolment policies and information

Re-enrolment for all existing Learn to Swim clients commences in week 7 and continues in week 8 of the school term. If you do not re-enrol during this period, we will assume that you have withdrawn from the program and your place will be offered to someone else.

- Week 9 is when wait lists will start to be processed.
- Week 10 is for change of days/times and registration of any siblings of current enrolments.
- New enrolments commence after Week 10.
  - Credits will only be given for children who are sick and provide a medical certificate. A maximum of 2 sick day credits per enrolment will be credited toward the following terms fees. Medical certificates will only be accepted for the current or previous term.
  - Assessments are carried out throughout the term. The instructor will notify our supervisor when a child is ready and an assessment will be conducted. If a vacancy does not exist for the child to move up a grade then

they will be placed on a waiting list and notified when the position becomes available.

- Please be aware that wait lists are only for children who are in our program and have completed an assessment. If you wish to change days or lesson times and a vacancy does not exist, you will need to keep in contact with the swim school reception to see if a vacancy arises in your specified class.
- No makeup lessons are available.
- A swim school tag will be issued upon enrolment. Please scan your tag at reception prior to each lesson. Please retain this card for all future lessons.
- All children under the age of 15 years in learn to swim lessons must be accompanied by a carer over the age of 16 years and closely supervised at all times.
- Notification of cancellation must be requested in writing and will become effective as of that date. Refunds may be considered but not guaranteed.
